All applicants will be notified about acceptance or rejection their papers via e-mail. Upon acceptance, participants are requested to cover conference fees (requisite elements is given below) and to send via e-mail a copy of the payment receipt to the Organizing Committee.

Conference Proceedings will be published before the conference opening. All accepted papers will be in free access on the Conference website. They will be available for discussion for Program Committee Members and Conference participants during the conference only. Conference Program and Proceedings will be presented to the participants at the registration desk.
